SYNOPSIS

The disturbance that brought flurries and freezing rain to much of central Alberta on Wednesday is now moving to the east. Most of the cloud associated with it has cleared. In spite of a cooler airmass, sunshine will allow temperatures to recover to near average values. Skies will remain clear this evening, but temperatures will only fall to near average values as west winds develop in Calgary. Lighter winds will prevail in Edmonton, resulting in the coldest night so far this fall – albeit near the seasonal average.
